## Support for **Opal Australian Paper** workers

## Any worker who is made redundant will be eligible for:

- Intake and case management services
- Training support including funded training
- Employment assistance services including the utilisation of Jobs Victoria Services and Skills and Jobs Centres
- Mental health and wellbeing support
